## MABAS 19 and 22 Supplemental Dispatching Procedure For Water Disaster Out of MABAS 19 & 22 Jurisdiction Responses

### Out of MABAS 19 & 22 Jurisdiction:

For the purpose of MABAS responses, a “water disaster out of MABAS 19 & 22 jurisdiction response” is defined as a predetermined response to another MABAS division (within Illinois) that has already used its available resources (The “water disaster out of MABAS 19 & 22 jurisdiction” shall be referred as “Response Team” for the remainder of this form). A Response Team musters at a given destination, responds as a unit, and is able to communicate on a common radio frequency. It will be the discretion of the Response Team Chief and 7800 if the Response Team has the ability to respond.

MABAS Division 19 & 22 has prepared a Response Team for flooding and/or other water related disasters. When another Division requests the Response Team to respond, the MABAS dispatcher will alert all Division 19 & 22 departments and advise them of the request. The Response Team (personnel) that will respond is determined by the shift color (on-duty personnel that day). If there is an insufficient amount of Response Team members available the off-duty members will be alerted to complete the Response Team. The Response Team will be a minimum of 10 members and a Chief Officer (7800 may respond with the Response Team Chief as an aid to any incident). The following locations are defined as mustering points in which the Response Team will assemble to respond to the stricken division.

Once a Response Team is requested the off-duty members will notify MABAS 19 Dispatch if they are available. This information is necessary to know so that the team leaders would know if the division has enough available members to handle a possible second incident.

Companies will respond to mustering points no lights or sirens; the Chief of Response Team will determine the response mode from mustering point to destination.

**Note:** Non-dispatched Response Team members may respond to the designated mustering point and be placed on appropriate responding vehicles. When responding, these team members should utilize the I-Am-Responding program (800-291-6142; 1 = responding, 6 = On-scene) to indicate their response.

#### **NORTH**

Assigned companies will meet at Palos Heights Station 1, located at 12300 S. Harlem Ave. From this point the assigned Chief will use the radio designation of Water Rescue Response Team 19 to communicate with the stricken division and will determine the best route of travel.

#### **EAST**

Assigned companies will meet at Frankfort Station 2, located at 20260 S. Graceland. From this point the assigned Chief will use the radio designation of Water Rescue Response Team 19 to communicate with the stricken division and will determine the best route of travel.

#### **SOUTH**

Assigned companies will meet at Peotone Station 1, located at 7550 W. Joliet Rd. From this point the assigned Chief will use the radio designation of Water Rescue Response Team 19 to communicate with the stricken division and will determine the best route of travel.

#### **WEST**

Assigned companies will meet at Lockport Station 6, located at 19623 Renwick Road in Lockport. From this point the assigned Chief will use the radio designation of Water Rescue Response Team 19 to communicate with the stricken division and will determine the best route of travel.

The assigned Chief will communicate with MABAS 19 dispatchers to advise them of when the Response Team has assembled and is proceeding to their assignment. The Response Team Chief should also give MABAS 19 regular updates during the duration of the incident.
